DRESS RHEARSALS (Mandatory)

Parents-Please drop your child off . We will have staff assigned to care for each group. No Non Performers or Non-staff permitted in auditorium during dress rehearsals.

Please bring a simple, healthy snack and water. please refrain from bringing pizzas, fast food, or other meals that attract the attention of others, and are messy.

Friday-June 11th at WINCHESTER THURSTON- 5-8 p.m.

This is a full dress rehearsal. All costume pieces must be worn with the correct accessories, shoes and tights. A list will be given to each class. We will rehearse the younger kids dances first and then Act 1 dances followed by, The pre-drama kids (The Tacky Penguin Play), (after this -all Pre-dance and kids 1 students may leave) then- Act 2-"Once in Atlantis" play in order with the dances. (except for pre-dance, and kids 1).

Saturday June 12th-at WINCHESTER THURSTON- **Call times**

11 a.m. -(in costume and on stage)

Full cast run through of the play, "Once In Atlantis" including all dance classes that are in the play. Classes that do not have their dance in the play such as Adult ballet 1/2 Teen tap, etc... will rehearse after this run through of the play at approximately 12:30.

Teen, and adult dances, and any others requiring extra stage rehearsal will practice. Children should rest, snack and get water at this time.

At this time the audience will be admitted to the auditorium. All performers must be off of the stage and in assigned dressing rooms. No performer is to leave the dressing area, or go and socialize in the audience.
